

DRIVEX STUDIOS SL – CONSENT & RECORD-KEEPING POLICY

Last updated: May 2026

1. Purpose of this Policy

DriveX Studios SL (“DriveX Studios”, “DriveX”, “we”, “our” or “us”) operates a professional audiovisual content platform intended exclusively for adult users and professional adult-content participants.

This Consent & Record-Keeping Policy establishes the compliance framework applicable to:

- performer consent;
- identity verification;
- age verification;
- image-rights authorizations;
- creator onboarding documentation;
- content traceability;
- retention of compliance records;
- audit documentation;
- lawful distribution rights;
- payment-compliance documentation.

This policy is intended to support compliance with:

- applicable Spanish and European laws;
- GDPR and data-protection obligations;
- Digital Services Act obligations where applicable;
- payment processor and acquiring bank requirements;
- Visa VIRP requirements;
- Mastercard BRAM requirements;
- anti-trafficking and anti-exploitation obligations;
- platform safety obligations.

This policy applies to all professional creators, performers, producers, studios, distributors, agencies, commercial partners and content suppliers whose content is made available through DriveX Studios.

2. Professional Content Platform

DriveX Studios operates as a professional adult audiovisual platform.

DriveX Studios does not permit:

- casual amateur uploads;
- anonymous creator uploads;
- unverified user-generated adult content;
- publication without prior verification procedures.

All content suppliers must undergo compliance onboarding procedures before publication rights may be granted.

3. Mandatory Verification Requirements

Before any content is published, distributed, monetized or otherwise made available through the Platform, DriveX Studios requires reasonable verification procedures intended to confirm:

- the legal identity of content suppliers;
- the age of all persons depicted;
- the legal capacity of performers;
- the authenticity of consent;
- lawful ownership or licensing rights;
- compliance with applicable laws and platform policies.

DriveX Studios reserves the right to deny onboarding, reject content or suspend publication where verification cannot be satisfactorily completed.

4. Performer Consent Requirements

DriveX Studios requires professional content suppliers to maintain valid and legally sufficient consent records.

Consent documentation must demonstrate that performers:

- were at least eighteen (18) years old at the time of production;
- participated voluntarily;
- were informed of the nature of the production;
- authorized recording and exploitation of their image and performance;
- consented without coercion, trafficking, intimidation or unlawful pressure;
- had legal capacity to provide consent.

DriveX Studios may require:

- signed model releases;
- image-rights agreements;
- performer consent declarations;
- production records;
- age-verification documentation;
- identity documentation;
- contractual authorizations;
- supporting compliance evidence.

Electronic signatures and secure digital execution systems may be used where legally valid.

5. Identity Verification Requirements

DriveX Studios may require professional creators, performers or suppliers to provide:

- government-issued identification documents;
- proof of identity;
- selfies or liveness verification;
- company documentation;
- beneficial ownership information;
- tax or business registration records;
- contractual authority documentation.

DriveX Studios may use:

- internal compliance procedures;
- specialized verification providers;
- fraud-prevention tools;
- manual verification review;
- third-party compliance systems.

Verification procedures may be updated according to:

- legal requirements;
- fraud risks;
- payment processor requirements;
- card-network standards;
- platform safety needs.

6. Age Verification Requirements

DriveX Studios applies measures intended to verify that:

- all performers are adults;
- all users accessing adult content are adults;
- minors cannot lawfully access restricted content.

Age-verification measures may include:

- government-issued ID review;
- third-party age-verification systems;
- identity verification tools;
- liveness verification;
- fraud screening;
- metadata review;
- compliance checks.

Any suspected attempt to bypass age-verification procedures may result in:

- suspension;
 - account termination;
 - reporting to authorities;
 - payment restrictions.

7. Content Traceability and Record Linking

DriveX Studios may maintain systems intended to associate:

- content files;
- performers;
- producers;
- rights holders;
- consent documentation;
- identity records;
- publication approvals;
- moderation decisions;
- compliance reviews.

Compliance records may include:

- content identifiers;
- upload dates;
- production references;
- audit logs;
- moderation history;
- distribution records.

DriveX Studios may implement internal systems intended to support traceability, auditing and lawful investigations.

8. Retention of Compliance Records

DriveX Studios and/or professional content suppliers may retain compliance-related documentation where reasonably necessary for:

- legal compliance;
- payment-compliance obligations;
- fraud prevention;
- dispute resolution;
- law-enforcement cooperation;
- platform safety;
- audit procedures;
- legal defense.

Retention periods may vary depending on:

- applicable laws;
- limitation periods;
- payment processor requirements;
- regulatory expectations;
- risk-management considerations.

DriveX Studios reserves the right to retain records for extended periods where reasonably necessary.

9. Secure Storage and Access Controls

DriveX Studios implements reasonable technical and organizational measures intended to protect compliance documentation.

Such measures may include:

- restricted access permissions;
- encrypted storage;
- audit logging;
- role-based access control;
- secure cloud infrastructure;
- authentication procedures;
- incident monitoring.

Access to compliance documentation may be limited to:

- authorized compliance personnel;
 - legal teams;
 - fraud-prevention teams;
 - trusted service providers acting under confidentiality obligations.

10. Compliance Reviews and Audits

DriveX Studios reserves the right to conduct:

- onboarding reviews;
- periodic compliance reviews;
- random audits;
- enhanced due-diligence procedures;
- re-verification procedures;
- payment-compliance investigations.

Professional content suppliers may be required to provide:

- updated documentation;
- verification records;
- production documentation;
- performer releases;
- distribution authorizations;
- moderation records.

Failure to cooperate may result in:

- suspension;
 - termination;
 - content removal;
 - reporting to payment partners.

11. Withdrawal, Revocation and Dispute Handling

Where legally applicable, performers or rights holders may submit requests relating to:

- withdrawal claims;
- impersonation claims;
- consent disputes;
- unauthorized publication allegations;
- privacy concerns;
- image-rights disputes.

DriveX Studios reserves the right to:

- request supporting evidence;
- suspend publication;
- preserve records;
- conduct investigations;
- cooperate with authorities;
- refuse unlawful or abusive requests.

The existence of a withdrawal request does not automatically require immediate deletion where:

- legal retention obligations apply;
 - evidence preservation is required;
 - lawful contractual rights continue to exist;
 - legal disputes remain pending.

12. Cooperation with Authorities and Payment Partners

DriveX Studios may cooperate with:

- judicial authorities;
- law enforcement;
- child-protection authorities;
- regulators;
- payment processors;
- acquiring banks;
- card networks;
- anti-fraud providers.

DriveX Studios may disclose or preserve records where reasonably necessary to:

- comply with legal obligations;
- investigate illegal conduct;
- prevent exploitation;
- prevent fraud;
- protect minors;
- satisfy payment-compliance obligations.

13. Prohibited Conduct

DriveX Studios strictly prohibits:

- falsified verification records;
- forged identification documents;
- fraudulent consent documentation;
- impersonation;
- publication without lawful rights;
- publication involving minors;
- coercive or exploitative content;
- trafficking-related conduct.

Violations may result in:

- account suspension;
- permanent termination;
- removal of content;
- reporting to authorities;
- legal action.

14. Third-Party Verification Providers

DriveX Studios may use specialized third-party vendors for:

- age verification;
- identity verification;
- fraud prevention;
- sanctions screening;
- liveness detection;
- compliance screening.

Use of such providers may be subject to:

- contractual safeguards;
- data-protection obligations;
- confidentiality requirements;
- security reviews.

15. Limitation of Liability

DriveX Studios implements reasonable compliance measures but cannot guarantee:

- the absolute authenticity of all documentation;
- the absence of fraud attempts;
- uninterrupted verification systems;

- error-free compliance processes.

Professional content suppliers remain independently responsible for:

- the legality of their content;
 - performer verification;
 - consent collection;
 - rights clearance;
 - lawful distribution rights.
